

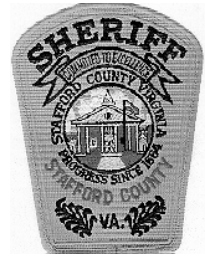

## General Assignment

### **CONSTRUCTION FRAUD**

**300 BLOCK OF GENTLE BREEZE CIR**

**ALPHA/ THE WILLOWS**

Complainant advised he contracted with the owner to install a pool with a handicap lift for his wheelchair-bound son, paid him a total of \$43,500 over the above-cited time frame, and no pool has been installed. Suspect called complainant in mid-December and advised he did not have money to repay, but would be able to complete the pool in the Spring after doing other installations. The landscaper who cleared a hole for the pool at the complainant's house advised the suspect owes him almost \$80,000 for 13 jobs he had done in various counties for the suspect.

### **LARCENY OF COPPER PIPE FROM VACANT HOUSE**

After a caller reported a vehicle trespassing and stuck in the mud in the back yard of the reference vacant county-owned house near the new reservoir, it was determined that all the copper pipe throughout the house had been stolen. [*The house had been forcibly entered sometime during 12/13-17<sup>th</sup> and the copper pipes exposed, but not stolen at that time.*] The trespassers advised they had gone in back to look at a trampoline; a search of their Jeep was negative for the pipe. While walking the property near the trampoline, deputy located 200-300 feet of electrical wiring in the woods nearby; it is unknown if it came from the reference house.
