Complainant (foreman) advised an unknown subject(s) stole nine 6" steel pipes (7' long) from the reference site; he advised he believes the suspects are probably selling them for scrap.

The window was completely shattered this date, with a small hole in the center, indicating a BB/pellet was used. At 1:31 am on December 5<sup>th</sup>, complainant on Grace Manor Court advised that between 5:00 pm and 12:45 am, an unknown subject(s) broke out the passenger side rear window and the rear window of his 1998 Plymouth van parked along the street in front of his home. Area checks were negative for additional incidents.
