Complainant advised he found two rear doors of his residence unlocked; he advised he is in the midst of moving, and the house is being shown for sale. He suspects unspecified subjects viewed the house and left the doors open to return later. A trash bag full of >250 DVDs was stolen from a closet; two other bags of DVDs were untouched. Two TVs, a refrigerator, and a trash compactor were stolen. About \$1,000 in scrap copper was stolen from the backyard. Multiple power tools were stolen from the garage, but several hundred other easily accessible power tools were not taken.

Victim (delivery employee) advised when he returned to the rear entrance of the business, he observed a W/M near the dumpster and thought it was an employee out smoking. When he rolled down his window, the subject put a knife to his throat. Suspect asked if he worked for Papa John's and then demanded his money. Victim turned over cash and credit card receipts; suspect left on foot, walking toward office park/ wood line. K-9 tracked toward an abandoned building at Chatham Heights Road and Butler Road, but it was secure and unoccupied. Suspect description matches a local resident with mental health issues with whom Sheriff's Office has had contact.
