Employees noted a vault door ajar and coins missing from various areas within the bank shortly after arrival; deputies noted tool marks on a rear door that is not frequently used. A review of surveillance video shows a subject that appears to be a female enter the bank from the back hallway that leads to the rear door. The subject crawls around the bank on their hands and knees and forces open drawers and doors to take money. They appear to be familiar with the bank interior. The suspect appears to be wearing a dark down jacket, dark ski mask and gloves, lighter pants (possibly jeans), and light colored ankle high shoes or boots with a dark sole.
