On Wednesday, January 30, 2008, complainant advised the back door of their residence was kicked in during the above-cited time frame. She advised they moved ten days ago because of problems with neighborhood kids. Her stepson advised of two former friends living in the woods at the back of the subdivision that he thinks might have been involved; both subjects were currently in lock up on different B&E charges. The subjects were 2 of 4 people caught in a vacant foreclosed house for sale in Shenandoah neighborhood; they were also reported for stealing and pawning tools belonging to one of their parents.
