

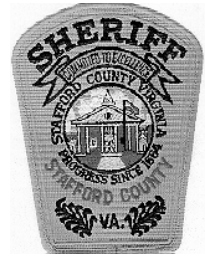

She advised the unknown subject(s) filled out a counter check with her account information to obtain the money; she is not missing any checks and does not know how the suspect obtained her account information.
