LARCENY (MONEY CHANGING SCAM)

BB&T/ 760 WARRENTON RD

ALPHA

Deputy responded to Wachovia Bank on Route 17 regarding an unknown B/M who attempted to confuse the teller about exchanging multiple bills for a \$100 bill at about noon. After an alert was sent to area banks, BB&T advised that the same subject had succeeded in the money changing scam at their location just prior to that. After receiving the \$100 bill, he presented a \$10 bill that he claimed the teller had given him in error and attempted to exchange it for a \$100 bill, scamming the teller out of \$90. The Wachovia manager saw the suspect leave in a gold minivan (possible 1990s Nissan style). The suspect was described as a 40-45 YO BM with scruffy beard, dark jacket and pants, with gray shirt.
