On Thursday, November 15, 2007, complainant advised that as he paid for groceries at SFW on November 14<sup>th</sup>, the clerk advised that the \$100 bill he gave them was counterfeit (turned purple when clerk put under black light). He advised it was one of five he received when he cashed his paycheck at the reference bank on November 13<sup>th</sup>. Deputy advised the watermark was Lincoln and the security thread was also for a \$5 bill; when run under water, the ink ran. It is believed a true \$5 bill was bleached and a scan of a \$100 was printed on it.
