

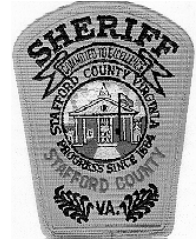

**APPLIANCE LARCENY FROM NEW HOME CONSTRUCTION**

Complainant advised that an unknown subject(s) stole the white washer and dryer from the laundry room of this just-completed new construction. The laundry room is next to the garage; it appears one of the garage doors had been left unlocked.

Complainant advised that after hearing his car alarm go off, he observed a sports vehicle leaving the area at a high rate of speed and noted the back window of his 2002 Toyota Prius parked on the street in front of his house was shattered, with a large hole in the middle. A metal house number "0" was found inside the vehicle and had been thrown with enough force to crack the front windshield as well. Area check revealed a 1997 Dodge Caravan parked on the street on Mourning Dove Drive had a shattered windshield; a bag of sand had been thrown on it.
