On Monday, November 26, 2007, complainant advised that an unknown subject(s) stole a \$7000 24-foot 2006 Vantage enclosed vehicle trailer from the reference site. It is white with no business markings, no VA registration, and had about \$5000 of plumbing supplies/parts inside when it was stolen.

FORGE & UTTER COUNTERFEIT \$5 BILL ALPHA

On Thursday, November 15, 2007, A/P advised a student attempted to pay for lunch with a counterfeit \$5 bill. The student eventually admitted he made the bill using his printer at home. It was darker and smaller than a true \$5 bill, and the white frame surrounding it was not uniform.

On November 27th, an employee realized that when they locked the back door, they were still able to open it by pushing on it. The door appeared to be pried open. An alarm had sounded at 9:23 am on November 22nd. It is not clear if entry to the business was made; the door opens to a hallway with motion sensors and another door; the suspect(s) may have been scared off by the alarm.

Complainant advised an unknown subject(s) shattered a 10x5 window (\$5000) on the front of the business; this is the third such incident at this business since October 30.

On Tuesday, November 27, 2007, complainant advised that he broke a \$100 at the reference business, receiving 5 \$20 bills. He advised when he attempted a purchase at Giant, he learned the \$20 was counterfeit. He took another one to his bank, which informed him it was counterfeit, too. He advised he had used the other three bills with no problems and did not know if they were counterfeit. The bill had no watermark, security strip, or color changing ink on the bottom right front of the bill.

At 4:00pm, school bus driver at Dixon Smith advised that when driving down the reference road at the above-cited time, the right side of his bus was hit by a BB; one student was hit in the face by flying glass, and another was hit in the shoulder by the BB. The driver finished his route before reporting the incident. At 6:58 pm, a FRED bus driver advised that after he dropped his last passenger at Meadow Drive and Town and Country Drive, he heard two shots, followed by the rear emergency glass shattering. An apparent BB hole was noted in the glass. The shot appeared to come from the area off Meadow Drive, possibly Coventry Court (backs up to Town and Country Drive).
