Elderly victim advised that he had placed an ad in the paper to sell numerous items, and on November 3rd, a male and female who have bought items from him in the past were at the house. The male inquired about buying four 5-gallon buckets of copper and galvanized steel plumbing fittings and an 18" pipe wrench; the victim advised him they were not for sale. Victim also mentioned he would not be home on November 4th; on Monday, November 5th, he noted the buckets and wrench missing. He advised he leaves his side door unlocked. He advised both subjects were about 40-50 YOA and the male was dark skinned (though not Black), with an unknown accent.
