On Saturday, October 13, 2007, complainant advised that three times during the above-cited time frame, she has seen an unknown B/M in the area of her children's bus stop about the time children are dropped off. She advised he is always in a delivery van or vehicle at or near the bus stop. She last saw him there on October 12th, in a marked DSL (sic) delivery van. When she parked down the street, he approached and asked why she parked there; when she advised to pick up her children, he advised the DSL van belonged to a friend and left the area in a hurry. She advised that, to her knowledge, the unknown B/M has not approached any children or any other people.

Complainant advised of 8-10 unknown B/Ms possibly wearing bandanas fighting in the reference area. The subjects had exited an unknown red vehicle, silver vehicle, and tan vehicle and formed a circle around a single subject; complainant advised it appeared the middle subject was being jumped by the others. All the subjects were wearing sleeveless white tee shirts. All the subjects (including the middle one) got back into the vehicles and left; they were gone on deputies' arrival, and area canvas was negative.
