Initial complainant (employee at coffee shop) advised an unknown B/M entered, went back to the bathroom multiple times, and then sat on a couch in the middle of the shop, where she saw him expose himself and appear to masturbate. The subject left as complainant called her manager. Shortly thereafter, second complainant (employee at party store) advised a subject of the same description had just exposed himself in their store. He apparently left while she called in the incident; area canvas was negative. A similar incident with a similar subject occurred at Tropical Café on Celebrate VA Pkwy one week before, the same day of the week and general time frame (Thursday, October 11th). Later on October 18th, Fredericksburg PD advised of a similar incident at 7:30 pm that evening at Nine West in their Central Park shopping area; in addition, their prior call checks confirmed a similar incident in Central Park on Thursday, October 4th at 12:30 pm. All five reported incidents have occurred on a Thursday; four in the evening, and one in mid-day. All three Stafford incidents took place in the same general retail area of South Stafford; both Fredericksburg incidents took place in Central Park.
