

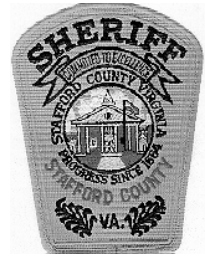

GRAND LARCENY (APPLIANCES FROM UNOCCUPIED HOME)
100 BLOCK OF BEREA WOODS DR

ALPHA/ BEREA ESTATES

After receiving a report of two trucks in front of an unoccupied residence owned by the County, deputy found boards across the back door had been removed and the storm door forced open. A County Supervisor advised a microwave and stacked washer and dryer have been stolen. He also advised that the house was previously broken into, with copper pipe and wiring stolen. It could not be determined if the white Toyota pickup and white pickup with utility bed sighted at the house were related to the larceny.
