Complainant advised that at the above-cited time, he heard his company-owned van parked in his driveway start, ran outside, and saw an unknown subject(s) driving off in the van. He advised he had been working on the van the day before and left the keys in the ignition with the vehicle unlocked. It is a 1994 Dodge panel van, white with blue top, ladder rack on top, loaded with a generator (used to wash vehicles), NC/LPH3227.

The necklace was a 24" gold chain with cubic zirconium stones embedded in an attached cross (\$350).
