Deputy noted handgun grip under driver seat of gray 1990 Honda Accord (VA/XZR4286) with loud music playing at reference motel. Investigation revealed it was an **authentic-looking semi-automatic pistol with rubber grip, magazine, and working slide; it was determined to be a BB gun**. There was also a **box of .25 caliber bullets** in the driver door and a **single .16 gauge shotgun shell** on the driver floorboard. Suspect/driver advised the BB gun was his, but not the ammunition.

**COUNTERFEIT \$500 AMEX TRAVELERS CHEQUES
300 BLOCK OF WEST PARK DR**

DELTA/ PARK RIDGE

Complainant advised he received a UPS package with a return address in Staten Island NY that contained three \$500 American Express Traveler's Cheques in a sealed plain business envelope. UPS tracking checks revealed the package had originated in Stockton CA on 9/24/07. Deputy's checks confirmed the traveler's cheques were counterfeit, with the same "Traveller's" misspelling mentioned in an information bulletin from Fredericksburg PD.
