Complainant advised that during the above-cited time frame, an unknown subject(s) forced entry to the commercial building under construction at the reference address, damaging the front door and frame. Four rolls of #10 copper wire (500 feet) and six partial spools (total length 500 feet) were stolen. The only unit broken into was the only one that had copper. Complainant advised that about a week before, two unknown men inquired about scrap metal, but were looking in the units under construction instead of the dumpster.
