When victim stopped by to pick up some documents, suspect struck him repeatedly in the head with a hoe, and hit and kicked him. He also threatened to kill him, his girlfriend, and her family if they called the police. Suspect and his girlfriend also intimidated victim's girlfriend and mother who were trying to stop the assault, threatening to kill them if they called police.

Complainants advised they had no contact with their 85 YO mother who suffers from Alzheimer's disease for 2 days and found her power and phone cut off. They were concerned because her renter had been acting strange recently and preventing them from speaking with her. At the beginning of the week, they had reported the renter for possibly stealing \$15,000 from their mother, and now both of them are gone, along with her passport. Checks revealed the renter quit his retail job on Thursday. The sons believe suspect might have convinced her to go to Germany, where she emigrated from.
