Complainants advised someone broke the windshields on 9 trash trucks and a 1995 Ford Mustang. Every truck in the lot but one was damaged. The windshields were struck by an object similar to a bat or hammer, some multiple times. Several also had both passenger and driver side windows broken as well. The Mustang appeared to have been struck by a bullet (possibly high-powered rifle), with the bullet entering the windshield, going through the visor and the rear passenger seat panel, and exiting the rear quarter panel below the window. The driver side window was also destroyed.
