

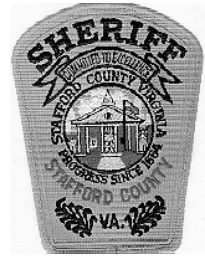

**CREDIT CARD SCAM**

**WAL-MART/ 217 GARRISONVILLE RD**

**DELTA**

On Sunday, August 17<sup>th</sup>, complainant advised a cashier had received a phone call from a female purporting to be a military service member deployed to Iraq that wished to add \$900 on a gift card she bought at Wal-mart for her son's use in Stafford. She was told someone would have to come in the next day to sign the credit card and advised she would send her mother. No one ever came in to sign the transaction. Wal-Mart was later advised the credit card used was invalid; complainant advised that several Wal-Mart locations throughout the country have been scammed (3 locations in Colorado, Minnesota, 2 locations in California), all for \$900 and with the same credit card.
