## General Assignment

### May 2008 – August 2008

#### **CREDIT CARD THEFT/ FRAUD**

#### **QUARLES GAS PUMPS/ 271 WARRENTON RD**

**ALPHA**

On Sunday, August 10, 2008, complainant (truck driver) advised a Quarles gas card he had loaned his daughter for emergencies was used fraudulently in over 60 transactions in 3 jurisdictions for \$1900. 30 of the transactions occurred in Stafford. His daughter advised she had not used the card and believed it was still in her wallet; when she found it missing, she suspected her boyfriend. He denied taking or using the card.
