On arrival home, complainant found the back kitchen door to their deck under construction was off its hinges. Pry marks were noted; it appeared an unknown subject(s) was unable to pry the door open and removed the hinge pins to gain access. The basement door also had obvious pry marks; it had been locked, but was unlocked when checked. Three guns were stolen from a bedroom. Numerous collectibles were also stolen. Old prescription bottles hidden in the closet were scattered on the floor, but complainant was unable to tell if any were missing. Complainant mentioned a cousin with a drug problem who lived with her in the past as a possible suspect.

Complainant advised an unknown subject(s) stole a hand held leaf blower and backpack leaf blower from the back of his 2006 Ford F150 parked in front of the store while he was inside. He found the tailgate down, and two trash bags that had been in the bed were on the ground. Surveillance video shows an unknown subject in a dark late model 4-door car pull up next to the truck at about 10:00 am; the subject walked around the truck, but it was not possible to tell if they took anything from it.
