A Stafford County Deputy responded to the Wingate Inn reference a suspicious vehicle. The Deputy learned the suspicious vehicle belonged to a registered guest and had been towing three vehicles, which had been removed from the accompanying trailer and were missing.

The investigation revealed the victims had used their 2008 Dodge Ram and accompanying trailer to pick up three vehicles (two Dodge Chargers and a Nissan Pathfinder) from the Fredericksburg Auto Auction for transport. They further learned the Dodge Ram had been entered (door lock damaged) and several items had been removed: keys to the missing vehicles (had been in the center console), a computer, a grey keyboard and a shoulder bag that contained a computer, company receipts and a checkbook. The investigation also revealed that all locks to the trailer had been cut / removed in order to lower the ramps and allow access to the three missing vehicles.
