**RESIDENTIAL B&E/ LARCENY (COPPER HVAC COIL)

On Saturday, February 16, 2008, complainant advised he purchased the reference house several weeks prior and had modifications made before moving in on February 15<sup>th</sup>. He noted heating problems and discovered the copper coils on the heating system (worth about \$1,000) had been stolen, most likely while the house was unoccupied. Nothing else was taken or disturbed.
