**ATTEMPTED LARCENY/ FALSE PRETENSE/ CONSPIRACY
BED BATH & BEYOND/ 1190 STAFFORD MARKET PL**

DELTA/ STAFFORD MARKETPLACE

Manager advised a W/M attempted to use a legitimate sales receipt from Saturday, February 16th, to fraudulently "return" items actually taken from the store shelves Tuesday, February 19th. A similar incident with the same sales receipt had occurred on Sunday, February 17th, where the suspect "returned" over \$300 in items and got cash refund. Tuesday, the suspect left in a black Jeep Cherokee when the manager confronted him. Another W/M who entered right after the suspect and left just prior to him appeared to be associated. Sergeant was able to determine a new address for the suspect on February 23rd and located both the Jeep and the suspect, who confessed to both incidents. His father had made the original legitimate purchase. Suspect advised the other subject with him was a friend who convinced him to do it and is good at scamming items at stores. Suspect admitted to being addicted to prescription pain pills.
