

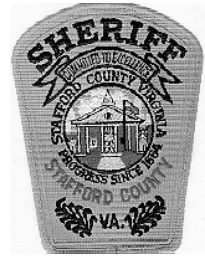

**LARCENY OF METAL FROM NEW CONSTRUCTION SITE

A caller reported an unknown W/M at the reference new construction site loading steel into a blue station wagon with wood colored trim. Deputy in area had him in sight and directed him to pull over when the subject began to leave. Deputy located 115 pieces of rebar (worth \$368) in the back of the 1990 Buick station wagon (VA/JZJ6673). The suspect initially claimed he had permission to take the rebar because it was scrap metal; he eventually admitted he was taking it to sell because he had fallen on hard times and offered to return it in exchange for a warning. **Checks revealed the suspect had been charged in two similar incidents of metal larceny from a construction site or business in the past 4 months** and had been a suspect in a larceny of metal from behind a store in the past.
