Complainant advised an unknown subject(s) stole his wife's unlocked green 1995 Lincoln Town Car on Sunday evening parked in the driveway with the keys inside; Monday morning, it was parked in a different location in the driveway. Monday evening, the car was stolen again; it was left in a nearby field Wednesday morning with the keys in the ignition. The second time, it was damaged: driver side brake light and passenger side headlight cracked, & numerous scratches along passenger side. Complainant had a suspect he would not name, advising he wanted to speak to the subject's mother first.
