On Friday, March 21, 2008, complainant advised suspect has cashed six fraudulent commercial checks with his business' account information at locations in Caroline, Spotsylvania, Fredericksburg, and Stafford for a total of about \$12,000. The suspect was identified by bank tellers by using his NC D/L.
