On Friday, March 28, 2008, complainant advised they suspect an elderly Stafford resident might be getting defrauded by her caretaker, who has been given durable power of attorney. It came to their attention when the resident & caretaker were in FL visiting the resident's brother, and they attempted to withdraw \$8,000 via a drive-through teller. Complainant found \$28,000 has been removed from the resident's account, a \$50,000 IRA was cashed out & unaccounted for, & a WDC property sold for \$465,000.

The vehicle was stopped on Warrenton Road, where the female advised she had just used the money at 7-Eleven to buy gas, and their checks with a counterfeit pen proved it was a legitimate bill. She advised she was going back to WaWa to advise them and mentioned she had gotten the bill from her brother. The 7-Eleven later advised that further checks revealed the bill did not have a security strip or watermark when held up to the light. WaWa advised their electronic reader/ scanner had rejected the bill twice.
