On Monday, March 3, 2008, buyer for an Ashland car company advised his company had bought a **charcoal/blue 2008 Ford F-250 crew cab truck** at the auction and left it in the dealer lot for transport to a Naples FL dealer. The keys were left in the gas cap. The Ashland company owner advised he last saw the truck on January 16th and has determined after a month of looking for it that the truck (worth \$36,500) has been stolen.

He planned to pick it up on Sunday, March 2nd. His employee advised seeing the machine being driven in the parking lot at about 4:30 pm on Sunday; he thought complainant was moving it.
