Complainant advised an unknown subject(s) stole cash from a kitchen drawer and from a bedroom drawer. There was no sign of forced entry, and nothing else was stolen.

LARCENY OF SCRAP METAL

FREEDOM MECHANICAL/ 1130 INTERNATIONAL PKWY #117 PARK

ALPHA/ STAFFORD INDUSTRIAL

An employee noted 2 older W/Ms stealing scrap metal belonging to the company from a trailer parked to the rear of the business. The metal was mainly commercial HVAC equipment (worth \$500) removed from jobsites. When confronted, the men unloaded the metal and left in their gray 1986 Ford pickup with a maroon stripe (VA/JZJ6673). The suspects were located and admitted they did not have permission to take the metal. The driver advised he gathers scrap metal from different locations to later take to recycling plants for money.
