

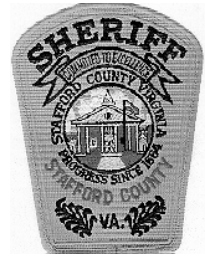

Employee advised he and owner monitor the reference self-serve car wash through video feed linked to their home computers. He was not able to get footage as of 4:00 am, and when he arrived at 7:30 am, he found damage to the front door (pried, lock bolt cut) and a vending machine case (pried, no entry), as well as a monitor and CPU stolen. A large amount of quarters and the petty cash box were not taken. The stored video footage from the on-site camera is on the stolen computer's hard drive.
