VANDALISM/ LARCENY FROM VEHICLE

Complainant heard glass break at a neighbor's house; when he went outside, he heard two young male voices that he thought went toward Partridge Lane. The windows on the complainant's 2005 Dodge Ram were broken out by a Spalding Top Flight pitching wedge, the head of which was recovered in the truck. K9 did track to the driveway of Partridge Lane, but not to a door; checks at the house were negative for further evidence. Area checks revealed ornamental lights broken at a number of residents at Windsong Way, and a black watch & flat gold Bengal bracelet stolen from an unlocked 2003 Ford Expedition in an open garage at Small Bear Court.
