

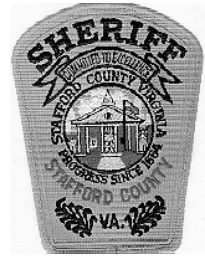

On Wednesday, October 29th, a 15 YOF advised her School Resource Officer (SRO) of a recurring incident at her bus stop; for the prior two weeks, an unknown man in a dark navy or black medium sized car has stopped to say hello while she is at the bus stop. Her parents told her to ignore the man, which she tried to do, but eventually said hi as he continued to speak with her. He advised his name was Herb. She advised he is balding, wears glasses, and is possibly in his thirties or forties. SRO waited at the bus stop the next morning, and the subject stopped again. When SRO encountered him and requested ID, he questioned why and became angry, claiming he had not broken any laws. He said he stops because he feels sorry that she has to stand at the bus stop alone, and advised he wouldn't talk to her again.
