

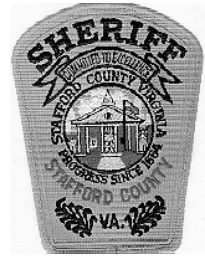

Deputy investigating a report of an abandoned scooter in a ditch with a chain around the rear tire determined the motorized scooter had been chained to a small tree at the reference address. An unknown subject(s) had dragged it from there toward the area of the Heather Hills subdivision; K9 track led toward a trail off Ficklen Road that led into Heather Hills near Ben Nuis Place, but no specific location was determined.
