

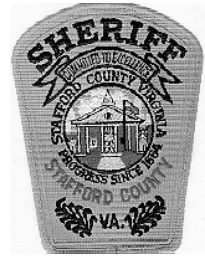

On Saturday, November 1st, complainant (GA resident) advised their credit card number was used at the reference Stafford store during the above-cited time frame. He advised it was also used at Wal-Mart locations in Fredericksburg & Spotsylvania, as well as a sub shop in Ashland. He advised he still has his actual credit card itself in his possession. Wal-Mart advised the card number was used to buy a \$200 gift card and a physical card was used in the transaction.
