

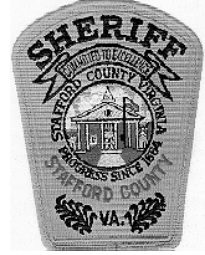

Tuesday, September 23, 2008- Friday, September 26, 2008 unknown –6:30 pm

**LARCENY OF GOLF CLUBS FROM OPEN GARAGE  
MOUNTAIN ASH CT**

**DELTA/ AUTUMN RIDGE**

Complainant advised an unknown subject(s) stole his \$450 set of golf clubs from his golf bag located in his garage; he often leaves the garage door *open*. There was no damage to the door, and nothing else was disturbed.
