


Weekly Crime Report

ALPHA ZONE:

25 South Gateway Drive Target 04/24/23
Larceny: Shoplifting (X2.)

106 Banks Ford Parkway 04/26/23

Burglary: Theft of floor lamp and A/C unit from a secured storage unit.

Preston Circle England Run 04/26/23

Fraud: SCAM: Victim received an email that instructed the victim to print the attached forms and take them to T-Mobile and pick up three (3) phones. Victim assumed it was a scam and ignored the email. A few days later, victim began receiving calls and text messages from an individual who identified himself as "Detective Robert" with the FBI and was attempting to convince the victim to "finish the job" and pick up the phones at T-Mobile. Victim chose to ignore the calls and text messages and report the scam to the Sheriff's Office.

11 Village Parkway Walmart 04/26/23

Larceny: Victim placed their cell phone down in the bathroom stall, and absentmindedly left the phone behind. Once the victim realized they didn't have their phone, they returned to find it missing.

Rivers Edge Drive Rivers Edge 04/27/23

Vandalism: Bathroom sink vanity damaged in an unsecured new home construction site. Monetary loss of \$189.

125 Royal Farms Way Royal Farms 04/27/23

Larceny: Theft of a an unsecured pole chainsaw from the back of a pickup truck.

Montera Avenue Celebrate Virginia 04/27/23

Fraud: Victim met suspect on a dating site, eventually exchanging personal contact information. Over a few months, suspect had requested financial assistance from victim, always repaying the funds to the victim. Suspect then requested a larger amount, again, with the understanding the monies would be repaid. Victim sent the funds, but this time, suspect did not repay, instead, made excuses for not paying back the borrowed funds. However, suspect continued to ask for additional funds from the victim, assuring repayment due to a \$7.5 million check the suspect was waiting to deposit; suspect even sent a copy of the check to the victim. Victim became suspicious and realized they had been scammed. The victim cut off all contact with the suspect and reported the fraud to the Sheriff's Office. Monetary loss of \$21,000.

Vandalism: Rear window of vehicle shattered.

9 South Gateway Drive Wawa 04/27/23

Larceny: Shoplifting.

460 Lendall Lane Healthy Generations Area Agency on Aging 04/27/23

Larceny: Theft of mail from their mailbox.

Westie Way Celebrate Virginia 04/28/23

Fraud: Victim's identity had been compromised and an attempt to establish a new line of credit was made. Due to security measures in place, the victim suffered no monetary loss.

Larceny: Shoplifting (X2.)

Falkirk Court Spring Knoll 04/29/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent check was created and an attempt to cash at two different banking institutions. Both identified the check as fraudulent, and victim sustained no monetary loss.

Larceny: Shoplifting.

282 Deacon Road Weis Markets 04/26/23

Larceny: Shoplifting.

Belle Plains Road 04/26/23

Fraud: Victim purchased a philodendron from "Gina Cinarcik", who sells plants. "Ms. Cinarcik" said she would have to import the plant from overseas. After waiting a week, the victim reached out, and "Ms. Cinarcik" said she was having problems with her importer. Months passed and still, no plant or contact from "Ms. Cinarcik" and the victim asked for a refund, which "Ms. Cinarcik" stated she didn't have the money to refund. Victim then asked if she could simply have a plant of equal value and "Ms. Cinarcik" stopped communicating with the victim altogether. Monetary loss of \$385.

Myrtle Road Hickory Ridge 04/29/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent bank account was established.

Kent Avenue Argyle Heights 04/29/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent account was established.

CHARLIE ZONE:

2996 Richmond Highway Staybridge Suites 04/24/23

Vandalism: Rear passenger window was damaged on victim's rental car.

Harpoon Drive Aquia Harbour 04/25/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent tax return was filed.

Mason Lane 04/25/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent loan with a "two-year" grace period payback was discovered when the victim was contacted for payment. Monetary loss of \$70,000.

Town Square Circle Towne Center 04/26/23

Vandalism: Victim's vehicle sustained cracks to windshield and dents in roof.

Abberly Drive Abberly Waterstone 04/26/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and an attempt was made to file a fraudulent tax return.

Larceny: Theft of backpack from a secured vehicle.

Fraud: Victim hired a contractor to complete an interior renovation. Contractor began the project, but never finished and is no longer returning the victim's calls. Monetary loss of \$44,382.

Aquia Drive Aquia Harbour 04/28/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a new bank account was established. Victim was able to freeze the account before experiencing any monetary loss.

DELTA ZONE:

1220 Stafford Market Place Kohl's 04/24/23

Larceny: Shoplifting.

217 Garrisonville Road Walmart 04/25/23

Larceny: Shoplifting.

Banner Spring Circle Austin Ridge 04/25/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and an attempt to establish a fraudulent bank account incurred.

Due to security measures in place, victim was able to freeze the account and sustained no monetary loss.

418 Garrisonville Road #1 Laundromat 04/25/23

Larceny: Theft of victim's wallet, purse, and cell phone from an unsecured vehicle.

Oakridge Drive Oakridge 04/27/23

Fraud: Victim's online Publix account was compromised and sustained a fraudulent charge.

1005 Stafford Market Place Panera Bread 04/27/23

Larceny: Theft of victim's wallet from their purse, while it was hung on the back of their chair.

Cabin Court Cabin Creekwood 04/28/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent AT&T account was established. Monetary loss of \$1,109.36.

217 Garrisonville Road Walmart 04/28/23

Larceny: Theft of wallet when victim accidentally left the wallet on the counter.

Magnolia Drive Magnolia Woods 04/29/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent bank account was established.

Fraud: Business credit card was compromised and sustained substantial fraudulent charges.


