

Weekly Crime Report

April 3rd — April 9th, 2023



ALPHA ZONE:

25 South Gateway Drive Target 04/03/23

Larceny: Shoplifting (X4.)

503 Deacon Road Dixon Smith Middle School 04/06/23

Larceny: Theft of student's Beats headphones from an unsecured locker.

Mountain View Road Mountain View 04/07/23

Fraud: SCAM: Victim received a call from Verizon inquiring whether the victim had given anyone permission to order phones on the victim's account, to which the victim confirmed no one had permission. Verizon representative explained two (2) Apple iPhone I4s Pro Max had been ordered and would arrive at the victim's home soon. Victim was further instructed to accept the order and return to Verizon for a full refund. Meanwhile, a UPS driver was approached by two (2) gentlemen asking to get the two packages off the UPS truck, showing the driver their tracking numbers. Coincidentally, these same two individuals had been noticed in front of the victim's home earlier in the day with the hood up on their car claiming to have car problems. The UPS driver contacted the victim and asked if he could release the two packages to the individuals, the driver was told no, and further instructed to deliver the packages to the victim's home; UPS driver complied. Once at the victim's home, the UPS driver contacted the Sheriff's Office to inform them of the foiled scam. Potential monetary loss of \$3,000, however, due to the security measures of Verizon, UPS, and the victim, no loss was sustained.

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent bank account was established. Four (4) fraudulent transfers sustained with a monetary loss of \$107, 839.

BRAVO ZONE:

Larceny: Theft of a purse from a secured vehicle.

Larceny: Victim lost their credit card and an unknown suspect found the credit card and posted a picture of it on Snapchat. Several fraudulent charges were attempted, but no monetary loss was sustained.

1280 Richmond Highway Liberty Gas Station 04/09/23

Larceny: Theft of 1,321 gallons of diesel fuel. Monetary loss of \$5,534.99.

Vandalism: Vehicle dented and scratched.

DELTA ZONE:

Mirage Drive Smith Lake 04/05/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent bank account and credit card accounts were established. Due to security measures in place, victim only sustained a monetary loss of \$263.

Lakeview Drive Lake Arrowhead 04/05/23

Fraud: Victim's credit card was compromised and sustained four (4) fraudulent charges in New York City. Monetary loss of \$123.13.

Penns Charter Lane Liberty Knolls 04/05/23

Fraud: SCAM: Victim received a text alert that appeared to be from the victim's banking institution. Moments later, victim received a call from their banking institution alerting the victim of fraudulent activity on their account. The caller proceeded to assist the victim in changing their password, all the while, victim was receiving messages of new accounts being established and alerts that money was being transferred out of their current account. When the victim asked the caller about these alerts, the victim was told this was to be expected, but not to be concerned. Additionally, the caller instructed the victim not to log into their account for a 24-hour period; victim complied. After 24 hours, the victim called their banking institution only to find there had never been fraudulent activity, and the victim had been scammed. Monetary loss of \$15,000.

Larceny: Theft of a firearm from a secured vehicle left overnight for repairs.

Newbury Drive Perry Farms 04/06/23

Fraud: Victim's credit card was compromised and sustained fraudulent charges. Monetary loss of \$337.28

Larceny: Shoplifting.






