# ALPHA ZONE



## **FRAUD**

Atlantic Union Bank, deputy responded to an attempted fraud. The victim advised he received notification someone was attempting to cash a fraudulent check at the bank. When the suspect did not receive the cash requested, he fled.

## **LARCENY**

Holly Corner Road, deputy responded to a larceny. The victim advised he was inside when he heard his vehicle start-up. When he went outside, he observed someone stealing his vehicle. The deputy was able to recover the unoccupied stolen vehicle later that day.

## **WEAPON OFFENSE**

Cynthias Place, deputy responded to a disturbance with a weapon. The caller advised they observed the suspect wearing a ski mask and brandishing a firearm. The deputy located the juvenile suspect and discovered he was in possession of a BB gun that looked realistically like a Glock. Criminal complaints for brandishing a firearm, carrying a concealed weapon, and wearing a mask in public were filed. The juvenile was detained at the Juvenile Detention Center.
