

Foggy Field Lane England Run North 02/25/23

Fraud: Victims hired contractor "Tarah Leonard" to work on their home. "Ms. Leonard" worked on the project, but advised the victims that she would need the remainder of the unpaid balance in order to finish the project; victims paid the remainder of the agreed amount of \$63,500. Victims were leaving town shortly afterward and "Ms. Leonard" promised to have the project completed prior to their return. Upon their return, the victims were met with an unfinished project, and "Ms. Leonard" is no longer answering their calls. Victims had to hire a second contractor to complete the project, costing an additional \$25,000.

Larceny: Theft of a 1987 Horton trailer.

125 Washington Square Plaza Walmart 02/20/23

Fraud: SCAM: PUPPIES: Victim negotiated the purchase of two (2) puppies with "Janice Alger". "Ms. Alger" requested payment prior to meeting to exchange puppies, which victim complied paying in three (3) increments of \$100, with the last payment sent via CashApp an hour before the meeting to pick up the puppies. Once the 3rd payment was received, "Ms. Alger" blocked the victim and never showed up with the puppies. Monetary loss of \$300.

25 Solomon Drive 7-11 02/20/23

Larceny: Theft of iPad and cell phone from an unsecured vehicle.

Larceny: Shoplifting.

Vesta Drive Briarwood Estates 02/22/23

Fraud: SCAM: APPLE: Victim was struggling to set up their Apple ID, and found a number online for customer service and called. The suspect who answered stated, in order to assist with the issue, the victim would need to purchase a \$500 Apple gift card; victim complied. The suspect went on to instruct the victim to purchase two (2) additional Apple gift cards, to which the victim complied as well, providing all the gift card information to the suspect. When the suspect requested a fourth card, the victim became suspicious and contacted the Stafford County Sheriff's Office, and found it had in fact been a scam. Monetary loss of \$1,500.

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent account was established. Monetary loss of \$165.

Cumberland Road Clearview Heights 02/23/23

Fraud: Victim's American Airlines online account was compromised and the victim's "miles" were fraudulently redeemed. Monetary loss of \$4,682.

Ferry Road North Ferry Farm 02/24/23

Fraud: Victim's debit card was compromised and sustained three (3) fraudulent charges. Due to security measures in place, victim incurred no monetary loss.

Hollywood Farm Road 02/25/23

Fraud: SCAM: PROPERTY RENTAL: Victim found a property for rent on Redfin.com and reached out to the agent, Roger Wellborn. After the victim spoke with "Roger", the victim decided to rent the property. "Roger" informed the victim of the monetary requirement which required the victim to transfer, via Zelle, three (3) different payments, for a total of \$4,050. Victim complied, however, not without complications. The initial email provided to the victim would not go through, at which time a second person, Sandra Strahosky, contacted the victim. After experiencing several issues, the victim drove by the property only to find it wasn't vacant, nor was it for rent. Victim realized they had fallen victim to a scam. Monetary loss of \$4,050.

125 Washington Square Plaza Walmart 02/25/23

Larceny: Theft of license plates from vehicle while victims were shopping.

Smith Street Potomac 02/26/23

Burglary: Items stolen from a crawl space under the victim's home.

Fraud: Victim's banking information was compromised and a fraudulent check was cashed. Monetary loss of \$2,000.

Barrett Heights Road Barrett Heights 02/22/23

Larceny: Theft of a wallet from an unsecured vehicle. Additionally, credit cards sustained fraudulent charges. Monetary loss of \$1,009.90.

Blueridge Court Cabin Creekwood 02/23/23

Larceny: Theft of an unsecured firearm from residence.

Wells Road Vista Woods 02/23/23

Fraud: Victim's banking information was compromised and an attempt for a fraudulent transfer of \$4,080 was made. However, due to the security measures the victim had in place, the transfer was blocked.

Larceny: Theft of jewelry from a secured safe.

Dacey Lane Rosewood Estates 02/25/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and various bank accounts were established. Victim was able to close accounts and freeze their credit, sustaining no monetary loss.




