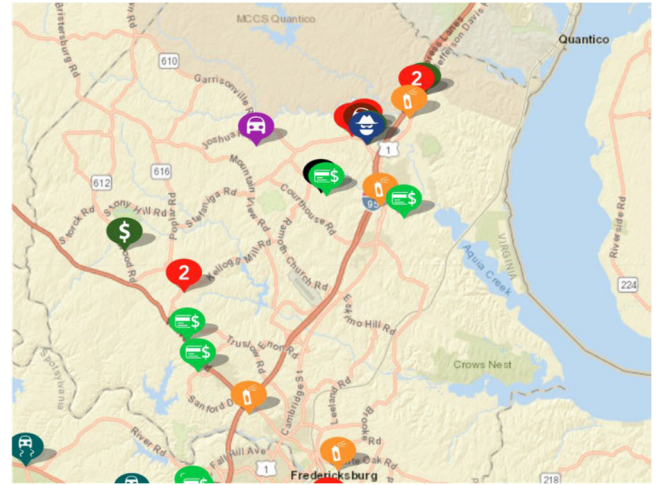

Fraud: Company's financial account was compromised and sustained a fraudulent charge. Monetary loss of \$8,800.

Larceny: Victim's wallet was stolen from their shopping cart by an unknown suspect.

Larceny: Shoplifting (X2.)

Fraud: SCAM: Victim received a call from an attorney stating the victim's son had been in an accident and had been arrested. The attorney was requesting \$120,000 to represent the victim's son. After further discussion, the victim and the attorney agreed on \$22,000. The attorney sent a courier to the victim's home to retrieve the money. After giving the money to the courier, the victim received a follow-up call from the attorney stating one of the victims of the accident had passed away and the victim's son was now being held on involuntary manslaughter, which required additional funds. It was at this time the victim suspected a possible scam and reached out to their son, only to discover the son had never been arrested or in an accident. Monetary loss of \$22,000.

ALPHA ZONE cont.:

9000 Celebrate Virginia Parkway Cannon Ridge Golf Club 02/12/23
Vandalism: Establishment was broken into and sustained a large amount of vandalism to include graffiti spray-painted throughout the building, broken mirrors, and broken windows.

BRAVO ZONE:

Kent Street Argyle Heights 02/07/23
Larceny: Theft of front license plate from a vehicle.

Revell Road Potomac Run 02/07/23
Fraud: **SCAM:** Victim received a call from the suspect identifying himself with the victim's bank. The suspect claimed there had been four (4) fraudulent charges on the victim's account and in order to troubleshoot and reverse the charges the victim was instructed to send payment. Victim sent \$2,200 and then attempted to send an additional \$2,300, twice, both times the transfer was declined. The phone call unexpectedly disconnected. The victim called their bank only to find out the original call had been a scam and the victim's bank had flagged the last two attempted transfers as fraudulent. Monetary loss of \$2,200.

Edwards Drive Grafton 02/08/23
Vandalism: Driver-side window of victim's RV was smashed.

43 Town and Country Drive UPS Store 02/09/23
Robbery: Suspect attempted to steal a watch off of a victim while they sat in their car.

125 Washington Square Plaza Walmart 02/10/23
Larceny: Shoplifting.

New Hope Church Road 02/10/23
Fraud: **SCAM: EBAY:** Victim found a vehicle to purchase on eBay. Victim reached out to the seller who stated payment would have to be two (2) gift cards or through eBay. Victim chose to purchase two (2) gift cards and provided the information to the seller. Shortly afterward seller reached back out to the victim and requested an additional \$1,000 for insurance, which at this point the victim realized they had been scammed. Monetary loss of \$1,000.

Pendleton Road Ferry Farm 02/12/23
Vandalism: Victim was at the park playing when a van arrived to pick up a group of kids from the park. Upon the van's departure, the driver of the van drove over the victim's scooter. Driver didn't stop and proceeded to leave the scene.

CHARLIE ZONE:

1700 Courthouse Road Brooke Point High School 02/07/23
Vandalism: Student punched fish tank causing the glass to shatter.

Puri Lane Summerwood 02/07/23
Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent account was established.

3263 Richmond Highway Castle Motorsports 02/08/23
Fraud: Suspect passed a fraudulent check for payment for a vehicle. Suspect was able to leave with the car before the business' financial institution was able to deem the check as fraudulent. Monetary loss of \$30,725.39.

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and several credit card accounts were established.

Rock Raymond Drive Aquia Overlook 02/10/23
Fraud: Victim's Instacart account was compromised and sustained several fraudulent charges.

Crestwood Drive & Twin Hill Lane Poplar Hills 02/10/23
Larceny: Theft of a 12-foot hauling trailer.

Lakeview Court Stone River 02/10/23
Vandalism: Victim's two (2) vehicles sustained broken windows and slashed tires.

Cookson Drive Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent bank account was established.	Spring Lake Farm	02/08/23
Whitestone Drive Fraud: SCAM: FAST LOAN: Victim applied for a loan with Fast Loans and was approved, however, the amount of the money transferred to the victim was far more than applied for originally. Victim called Fast Loans and was instructed to transfer the overage of the funds back to Fast Loans; the victim complied. The following day, the victim noticed their account was in overdraft. Additionally, the victim discovered several credit card accounts had been established, each card sustaining numerous charges. Monetary loss unknown.	Brentwood Estates	02/09/23
Providence Street Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and sustained a fraudulent charge.	Arbor Grove Apartments	02/10/23
317 Worth Avenue Larceny: Two suspects approached the service desk to purchase two (2) \$500 gift cards. Suspects handed the clerk \$1,000 in cash, which the clerk counted. The clerk placed the cash down and was distracted, at which time one of the suspects, unknowingly to the clerk, pocketed \$500 of the cash.	Giant Store	02/10/23
