


Weekly Crime Report

Averil Court Cardinal Forest 01/17/23

Fraud: Victim's bank account was compromised and sustained various fraudulent charges and transfers. Monetary loss of \$7,000.

Stony Hill Road Stone Hill 01/18/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and sustained various fraudulent charges. Monetary loss of \$2,212.

Mountain View Road Rosedale 01/18/23

Fraud: Victim's financial account was compromised and sustained various fraudulent charges. Monetary loss of \$9,000.

Fraud: Victim's wallet was stolen from their bag while it was hung on the back of their chair. Victim sustained various fraudulent charges; monetary loss of \$1,014. 89 within minutes of being stolen.

Larceny: Shoplifting.

Burglary: Victim's backdoor was pried open; resulting in the theft of personal and household items.

125 Washington Square Plaza Larceny: Shoplifting (X2.) Walmart 01/16/23

Truslow Road 01/16/23

Vandalism: Unknown delivery driver found herself stuck in the victim's front yard. She flagged down a truck and requested assistance in pulling her out. Once the delivery driver was unstuck, she left the scene without notifying homeowners and taking responsibility for the damage to their yard.

Belle Plains Road 01/18/23

Fraud: SCAM: USPS: Victim received a text from "USPS" stating the victim would need to update their home address to receive a package. Victim selected the link, which then required a \$3.00 payment to update information; victim paid. The next day, the victim received a call from a "representative" of their bank explaining there had been fraudulent activity on the victim's account. The "representative" stated their password would need to be changed due to the recent fraudulent activity. The victim changed their password with the "representative's" assistance. After the phone call, victim noticed a pending transfer of \$3,000. Victim contacted their financial institution directly to discover the previous text and phone call had been part of an elaborate scam. Due to victim's quick action, there was no monetary loss.

North Randolph Road North Ferry Farm 01/18/23

Fraud: Victim's EBT card was compromised and sustained fraudulent charges.

Wood Landing Road Wood Landing Estates 01/21/23

Larceny: Theft of three (3) wooden posts from a residential new-build construction site.

30 Town and Country Drive Mini Storage 01/21/23

Larceny: Theft of trailer from a storage facility parking lot.

CHARLIE ZONE:

Davenport Drive Ultris Courthouse Square 01/17/23

Fraud: SCAM: Victim received a call regarding their online resume. Victim agreed to an interview with suspect "Jessica McFadden." "Jessica" then sent a check for \$4,500 to the victim with instructions to deposit it into the victim's personal bank account and then forward payment to several contractors; victim complied. Shortly afterward, the victim's bank informed the victim the check had been counterfeit. Monetary loss of \$4,775.

Peregrine Court Quail Run 01/17/23

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and two (2) lines of credit were fraudulently established.

Town Square Circle Aquia 15 at Town Center 01/21/23

Larceny: Theft of rear license plate from a vehicle.

1555 Richmond Highway 01/22/23

Larceny: Theft of tools from a secured van.

DELTA ZONE:

1250 Stafford Market Place Old Navy 01/16/23

Fraud: SCAM: Suspect handed the clerk \$1,000 in twenty dollar bills to purchase his items. Clerk counted the money and sat it down on the counter. The suspect picked up the stack of bills and pressed against his chest and began to make small talk all in an attempt to distract the clerk. Suspect was able to pocket \$800 from the stack of twenty dollar bills without the clerk noticing, only handing back to the clerk \$200; the clerk did not recount. At the end of the shift, the clerk's cash register was short \$800.

Larceny: Theft of wallet from an unsecured vehicle.

Larceny: Theft of debit cards from an unsecured vehicle.

1090 Stafford Market Place Target 01/21/23

Fraud: Suspect entered the business and retrieved items off of the store shelves. Suspect then attempted to return the items to Customer Service using old receipts. After further investigation, it was discovered this was not the first time the suspect had returned items she had not purchased. Monetary loss of \$126.00.

1600 Mine Road Jeff Rouse Swim & Sports Center 01/22/23

Larceny: Theft of personal items from several secured vehicles (X4.)

800 Eustace Road H.H. Poole Middle School 01/22/23

Larceny: Theft of Steam Deck handheld gaming computer from student's backpack.

Regency Drive Park Ridge 01/22/23

Fraud: Victim's identity compromised. Suspect withdrew funds from a bank located in Pennsylvania using a fake I.D.. Monetary loss of \$3,000.

217 Garrisonville Road Walmart 01/22/23

Embezzlement: Employee processed returns and pocketed the monies. Monetary loss of \$667.63.

Palladio Drive Amyclae 01/22/23

Fraud: SCAM: TEXT MESSAGE: Victim received a text message stating their Amazon account had been compromised and had incurred fraudulent charges. Victim called the provided phone number to the Amazon Fraud Department. The victim was advised of several charges, which the victim confirmed were in fact fraudulent. The "Amazon representative" stated he was able to assist the victim in filing a claim and assist them in processing a refund to the victim's account. However, to do so, the victim would need to purchase various gift cards at various businesses to confirm the victim's location; victim purchased and provided all gift card information to the representative. Victim realized when they did not receive the refund as promised they had fallen victim to a scam. Monetary loss of \$4,200.

Larceny: Theft of employee's wallet by a fellow employee.

1220 Stafford Market Place Kohl's 01/22/23

Larceny: Shoplifting.

Bryant Boulevard Vista Woods 01/22/23

Vandalism: Victim discovered graffiti spray-painted on garage door of their residence.
