


Weekly Crime Report

ALPHA ZONE:

Arden Lane Manor Wood Estates 06/13/23

Fraud: SCAM: JURY DUTY: Victim received a phone call from a "deputy" with the Stafford County Sheriff's Office. The "deputy" informed the victim of missing jury duty and explained the victim could pay the fine or turn themselves in to the Sheriff's Office; the victim chose to pay the fine and sent payment via Zelle. Later, when the victim informed their spouse of the call, they realized it had been a scam. Monetary loss of \$1,000.

Ireland Drive Sullivan Estates 06/13/23

Fraud: Victim absentmindedly walked off leaving their debit card in the ATM after completing their transaction. The unknown suspect found the card and proceeded to use the card fraudulently. Monetary loss of \$267.69.

Babs Run Adeline Estates 06/14/23

Fraud: SCAM: PUPPIES: Victim was on Facebook and noticed a post for two (2) French Mastiffs for sale; Facebook profile name was "Dogue de Bordeaux & breeders". Victim responded to the listing and was messaged by the profiles administrator identified as "Jennifer Lee" who communicated with the victim at length through Facebook Messenger. Victim agreed to pay \$150 as a down payment on the dogs via Venmo, and the victim was provided a Venmo user name to send payment to "@moses-bradfoed-12". After making the payment, the victim was provided an address of 3698 Edgewood Avenue in Richmond. The victim was instructed that they could come to the residence that weekend to finalize payment and pick up the dogs. Victim proceeded to the given address which appeared to be valid as it was providing a pin-point location using GPS. When the victim arrived the victim found that the house number 3698 did not exist. Victim attempted to contact "Lee" through Facebook and the telephone number that was previously provided (252-477-3858). However, the victim was now blocked from the Facebook page and the phone number appeared invalid.

Larceny: Theft of catalytic converter from a vehicle.

Stonehaven Drive Stafford Lakes Apartments 06/14/23

Vandalism: Victim arrived home after being out of town to find their rear window smashed on their vehicle.

125 Washington Square Plaza Walmart 06/17/23

The purse was then turned in by a shopper, and upon further investigation, it was found that, initially, a woman had found the purse on the shelf, rummaged through it, and returned the purse to the shelf before the conscientious customer had turned in the purse to the Customer Service counter. Monetary loss of \$340 in cash.

Burglary: Theft of personal items from an unsecured residence.

Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent bank account was established. Victim was able to close the account and suffered no monetary loss.


