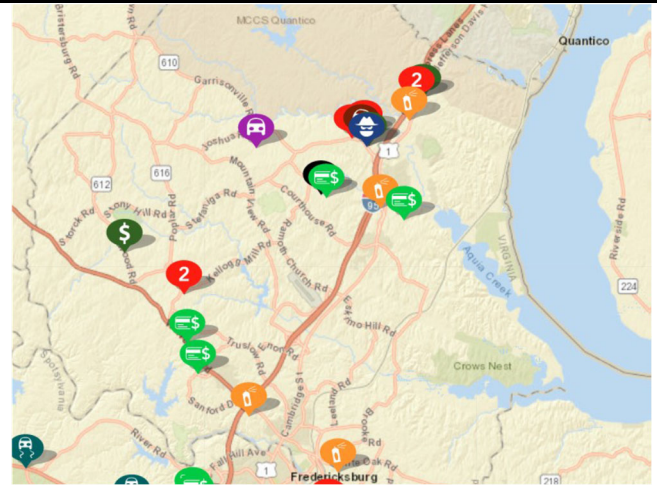

Maggie Court England Run North 07/01/23

Fraud: **SCAM:** Victim was contacted by the suspect to provide services; payment was agreed upon by suspect and victim. Victim received check for payment, however, the check was more than the agreed amount. When the victim pointed this out to the suspect, the suspect asked for the victim to send the additional funds to another individual; victim complied. Several days later, victim was informed by their bank that the check was fraudulent. Monetary loss of \$1,500.

11 Village Parkway Walmart 07/02/23
Larceny: Shoplifting.

BRAVO ZONE:

Westview Drive Holly Ridge 06/26/23

Fraud: Victim placed a deposit down with the suspect who claimed to be a "handyman" and was able to complete the work the victim needed to be completed. After the check was cashed, victim has no longer been able to contact the suspect. Monetary loss of \$1,000.

25 Solomon Drive 7-11 06/26/23
Larceny: Shoplifting.

486 Cambridge Street 540 Auto 06/26/23

Fraud: Victim hired contractor to install fencing around their property. A deposit was given to the contractor to purchase supplies for the project. The check was cashed within 24 hours of receipt, afterward the victim has been unable to connect with the contractor. Monetary loss of \$5,500.

327 Deacon Road 7-11 06/27/23

Fraud: **SCAM:** Store attendant received a call from an individual claiming to be an employee from a different 7-11 who was experiencing issues with their card reader at their store. The individual then requested the store attendant to process gift cards and provide the information to them, each time stating the card did not go through. After processing several cards, and told the cards were not going through, the individual disconnected. Only after reviewing the specifics of the event did the store attendant eventually realize this had been a scam. Monetary lost to the store of \$2,300.

Larceny: Theft of personal items from victim's secured vehicle.

282 Deacon Road Larceny: Shoplifting.	Weis Market	06/28/23
Anderson Drive Fraud: SCAM: COMPUTER: Victim was on their laptop when they received an audible alert stating their laptop had been hacked and to call the provided number; victim complied. Victim received a callback and was instructed to go to their bank, remove money from their money market account and wait for a courier to come to their home to retrieve the money for the purpose of establishing a new money market account for the victim; again, victim complied. Victim then shared their experience with a family member who was sure this had been a scam and directed the victim to contact the Sheriff's Office immediately. Victim sustained a \$60,000 monetary loss.	Mt. Pleasant Estates	06/28/23
Fannies Lane Fraud: Victim's identity was compromised and a fraudulent account was established. Monetary loss of \$976.00.		06/29/23
35 Town and Country Road Larceny: Theft of victim's wallet from their shopping cart.	Giant Food Store	06/29/23
Edwin Court Fraud: SCAM: JOB OFFER: Victim was contacted by email regarding a job offer; victim accepted. Victim was asked to assist with purchase orders, which the unknown suspect would send a check to the victim, victim would then deposit into their account, and then purchase items using their credit card. Shortly after making purchases, victim was notified the checks were fraudulent. Monetary loss of \$42,879.	Leeland Station	06/29/23
Shephard Court Fraud: SCAM: Victim received a letter in the mail from their financial institution instructing the victim to contact that bank to update account information; victim called provided number. After a few minutes on the phone, victim became suspicious and disconnected from the call. Victim looked up the phone number for their financial institution and noticed it was different than the number provided in the letter. Victim contacted their financial institution and was told they never send a letter to verify or update personal information. Due to victim's suspicion, they sustained no monetary loss and were able to flag their personal accounts.	Falmouth Village	06/29/23
Town and Country/Meadow Drive Vandalism: An attempt to hotwire a vehicle failed; vehicle sustained damage to steering column.		07/02/23

It was at this time, the female suspect pocketed \$300 of the cash, and gave the remaining \$200 to the attendant. The attendant was unaware of the switch. Monetary loss of \$300.

Fraud: Victim's CashApp account was compromised and sustained a fraudulent charge. Monetary loss of \$50.00.

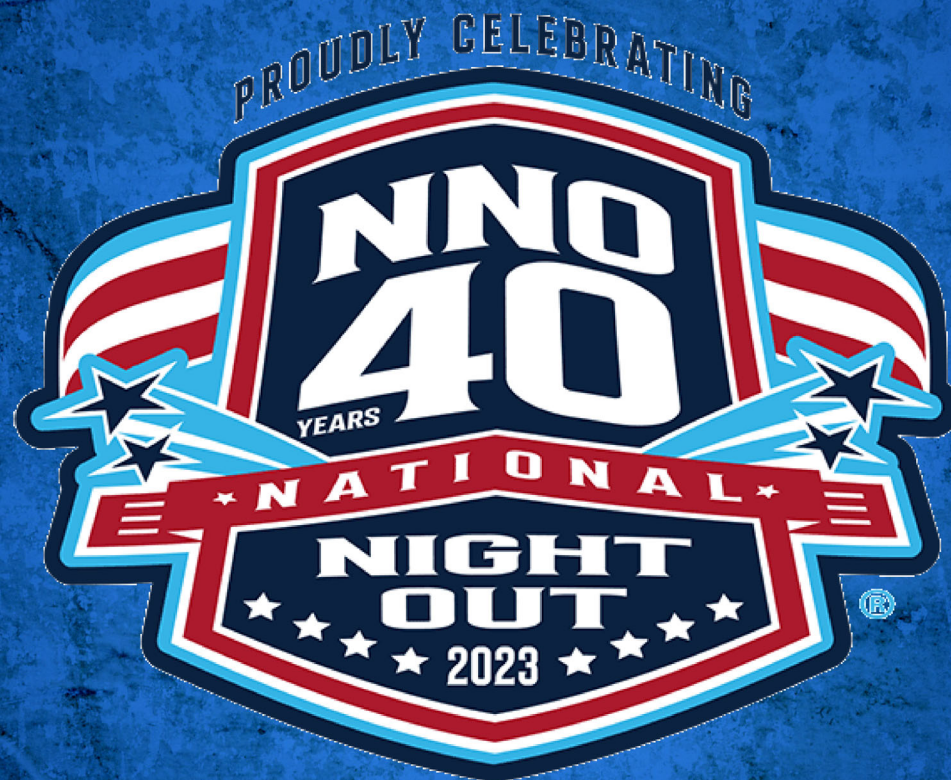
