Victim stated "No", the activity was not theirs. Victim then received a call from their financial institution regarding the fraudulent activity. Victim confirmed the security questions with the caller, at which time, the victim noticed several new fraudulent transfers being processed. Victim disconnected the call immediately and called their financial institution on their own only to find out this had been a scam. The financial institution's phone number had been "spoofed", and the victim suffered a monetary loss of \$22,500. 1141 Mountain View Road 06/10/23 American Legion Post 290 Counterfeit: Patron passed a counterfeit \$100 bill during Bingo.

Clear Springs Lane Southgate 06/11/23 Larceny: Theft of two (2) firearms during a recent move when the victim relocated from North Carolina to Virginia. Victim had hired additional help through U-Haul to assist in unloading their household items.

Marlborough Point Road Lyons Den 06/07/23 Fraud: SCAM: JURY DUTY: Victim received a call from an individual identifying himself as "Lt. Diggs with the Alexandria Police Department." "Lt. Diggs" proceeded to explain that the victim was being charged with "failure to appear" for jury duty. "Lt. Diggs" ordered the victim to pay \$2,000 via Zelle, which the victim explained they only had \$1,500. "Lt Diggs" said the additional \$500 would be forgiven and the victim transferred the \$1,500. Victim became suspicious and contacted the Sheriff's Office and a deputy explained this had been a scam. Victim was able to freeze the transaction and suffered no monetary loss.

Davidson StreetAlta Courthouse Square06/07/23Fraud: SCAM: Victim was contacted regarding a job opportunity with "SNC Lavalin Group" and scheduledan online job interview. Victim was offered the position and was advised they would receive a check for \$4,900 topurchase a computer and other required items for the position. Victim received the check, and as directed by thecompany CEO, "Steve Morris", deposited the check. Victim became suspicious when they saw an unfamiliar nameon the check, and googled, finding it to belong to an elderly woman in Houston. Fraud: SCAM: Victim received a call from an individual claiming to be with Amazon and they detected fraudulent activity on the victim's Amazon account. The victim was then transferred to a woman identifying herself as an "FTC Special Agent Grace Kim" and she advised the victim that their social security number and name had been used to launder money through Mexico, Columbia, and China, and the victim would need to complete the "asset validation" process to prove they played no part in the money laundering. The victim was then transferred to an individual claiming to be "DEA Special Agent Oscar White", who spoke with a heavy Indian accent. Victim was instructed by "Special Agent White" that they needed to transfer all their money in the bank to a "Crypto Machine". Victim googled "scam containing Agent Oscar White" and found several scam warnings. Victim disconnected the phone call, contacted their bank and Social Security Administration to check on any fraudulent activity, and to ensure proper security measures were in place. Victim sustained no monetary loss.


Fraud: SCAM: INFINITY: Victim was called by suspect identifying himself as "Allen J. Belfor" with Xfinity and was calling to assist the victim with their Internet speed. Suspect requested access to the victim's computer to check the Internet speed and the victim complied. Suspect then offered to send the victim a \$600 rebate to make up for the issue, but would need the victim to log into their bank account for the wire transfer to be completed. Victim was uncomfortable allowing access. The suspect and his associate, who had joined the call, became frustrated with the victim not budging and disconnected the call. Victim called the Sheriff's Office and confirmed this had been a scam. Victim suffered no monetary loss.

Winthrop WayHidden Valley Mobile Home Park06/10/23Fraud: SCAM: GEEK SQUAD: Victim received an email from "Geek Squad" with an invoice attached for\$449.98 for "services." Victim has never used Geek Squad and called the number in the email. Victim spoke with arepresentative who had a heavy Indian accent and poor phone connection and informed him of the error. The"representative" had the victim's banking information already and confirmed it with the victim. The"representative" said he would process a refund to the victim's bank, but then realized he had in error ANDrefunded \$4,000. "Representative" stated the victim had to pay it back immediately, and was instructed to purchasegift cards and provide the information to the "representative"; victim complied. Simultaneously, the victim noticeda \$13,000 transfer of funds wired out of their account. Victim still stayed on the phone with the "representative"while purchasing the gift cards. It was at this time an off-duty law enforcement officer overheard the victim on thephone and stepped in and had the victim disconnect from the call. The Sheriff's Office was contacted and a deputyassisted the victim in contacting their financial institutions to ensure security measures were in place to preventadditional and future fraudulent events. Unfortunately, the victim still suffered a \$2,000 monetary loss.


