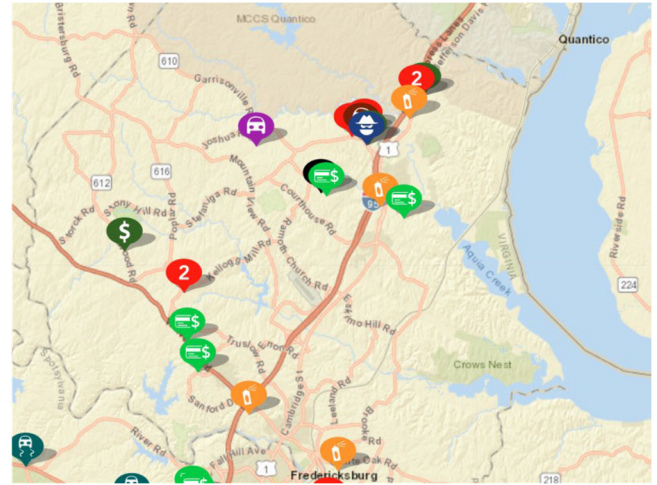

| Fraud: SCAM: Victim received a call from their 'son', whose voice sounded different. 'Son' explained he had been in a bad accident and was hurt as well as responsible for hurting a pregnant woman. Victim's 'son' stated a lawyer would be calling soon. A lawyer called and stated the bail for their son was \$240,000; however, the victim only had access to \$10K. The lawyer accepted the amount and hired a driver to pick the cash up, promising the victim that the money would be returned once their 'son's' trial was over; the victim gave the cash to the hired driver. The victim then became suspicious and attempted to call and text the number the lawyer had called from but to no avail. Victim reached out to their son and discovered he had not in fact been in a car accident. Monetary loss of \$10,000. | | |

Fraud: **SCAM: JURY DUTY:** Victim received a phone call from "Captain Carey" of the Stafford County Sheriff's Office. The Captain informed the victim that a bench warrant had been issued for them for having missed jury duty. However, the victim could pay a fine of \$1,000 using Zelle, and the bench warrant would be cleared. Once the victim processed payment, they were directed to meet "Captain Carey" at the Sheriff's Office. The victim followed directions and went to the Sheriff's Office. When the real "Captain Carey" met with the victim, he informed them he had not called and the Sheriff's Office would never call and demand payment. Monetary loss of \$1,000.

Larceny: Victim was selling a pair of shoes, Jordan 4 Military Black size 11.5, on the website OfferUp. The victim agreed to meet two (2) individuals in front of Kohl's to sell the shoes to them. Suspect handed the victim three (3) \$100 dollar bills, and when the victim went to unfold the bills, one of the suspects grabbed the shoes out of the victim's possession and both suspects took off running. Victim realized the suspects had paid with counterfeit money. Monetary loss of \$300.

Fraud: **SCAM: GIFT CARDS:** Victim received a text from someone claiming to be the victim's 'pastor'. The 'pastor' then asked the victim to purchase gift cards and provide him with the card information; the 'pastor' would reimburse the victim when he saw them at church. Victim was suspicious and contacted their church only to discover several other members had also been contacted with the same request. The victims realized it was a scam, and no one sustained any monetary loss.

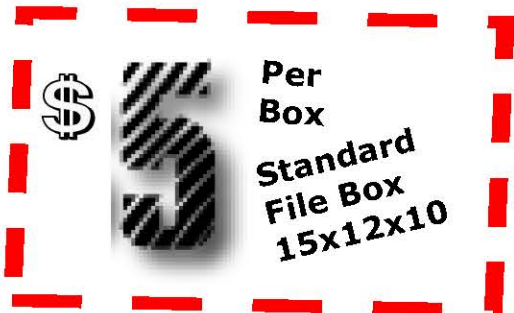
