Royal Crescent Way Stafford Lakes Village

Fraud: SCAM: Victim was on their laptop when it froze up and a pop-up message appeared on the screen. The message instructed the victim to call Microsoft Customer Services and victim complied. Victim spoke with a customer service representative who explained there was a problem with the victim's IP address and someone would call them back to assist with rectifying the situation. Victim received a call from 'Jason Williams' and he instructed the victim to withdraw money from their bank account and transfer it to Bitcoin; victim complied once again. Once completed, the victim followed up with a QR code that had been sent to them by 'Max Wilson', another Microsoft representative. Afterward, victim became suspicious and called 'Max' back. The individual who answered the phone said 'Max' was part of a fraud team and had left for the day. Victim realized the event, in it's entirety, had been a scam. Monetary loss of \$9,480.

Additionally, suspect explained the victim would need to transfer \$1,000 to the suspect, in order to activate the account, assuring the victim the money would be returned upon account activation. Victim made the transfers, afterward, victim was no longer able to get in touch with the suspect and received no refund. Monetary loss of \$710.47.

Larceny: Theft of truck bed cover from vehicle.


Mt. Olive Road 03/26/23
