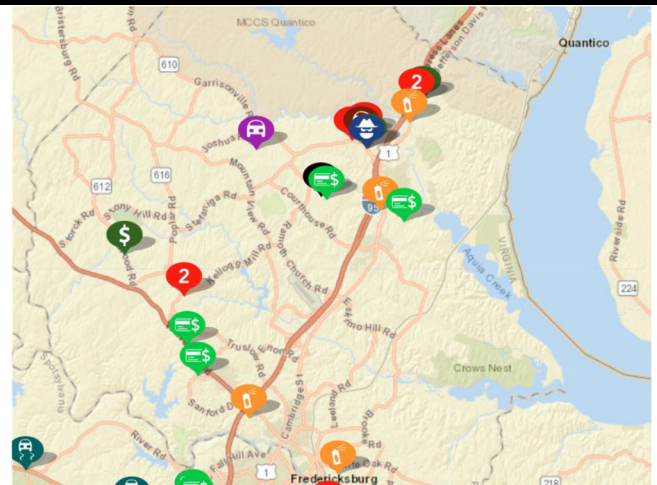

The realtor conducted their own investigation and found the individual who had contacted them did not in fact own the land and was attempting to fraudulently sell the land for profit.

Fraud: SCAM: Victim contacted 'Aria' via Facebook regarding the purchase of a horse. 'Aria' encouraged the victim to place a deposit on the horse due to so many people expressing interest in this specific horse. Victim agreed, but requested to speak to 'Aria' on the phone. After the call, the victim felt 'Aria' was not who she claim to be and this could be a potential scam. Victim then requested their deposit back. 'Aria' continued to make excuses for not returning the deposit and eventually stopped communicating with the victim; the victim never received their deposit back. Monetary loss of \$1,000.

Anchor Cove Fraud: SCAM: Victim was contacted through Facebook by an individual they believed to be an associate they had conducted financial business with in the past. This individual informed the victim they had won a financial prize through cryptocurrency, and in order to receive it they would be required to send two (2) small monetary transfers via their cryptocurrency account; victim followed instructions. Shortly afterward, the victim's account sustained a fraudulent transfer. Victim reached out to the associate only to find he had not been in touch with the victim and the victim had been scammed. Total monetary loss of \$2,450.	Aquia Harbour	05/27/23
Snow Meadow Lane Larceny: Victim's license plate from a previously owned vehicle was stolen and used on a different vehicle, which then incurred a speeding violation captured by a speed camera. Monetary loss of \$50.	Summerwood	05/28/23

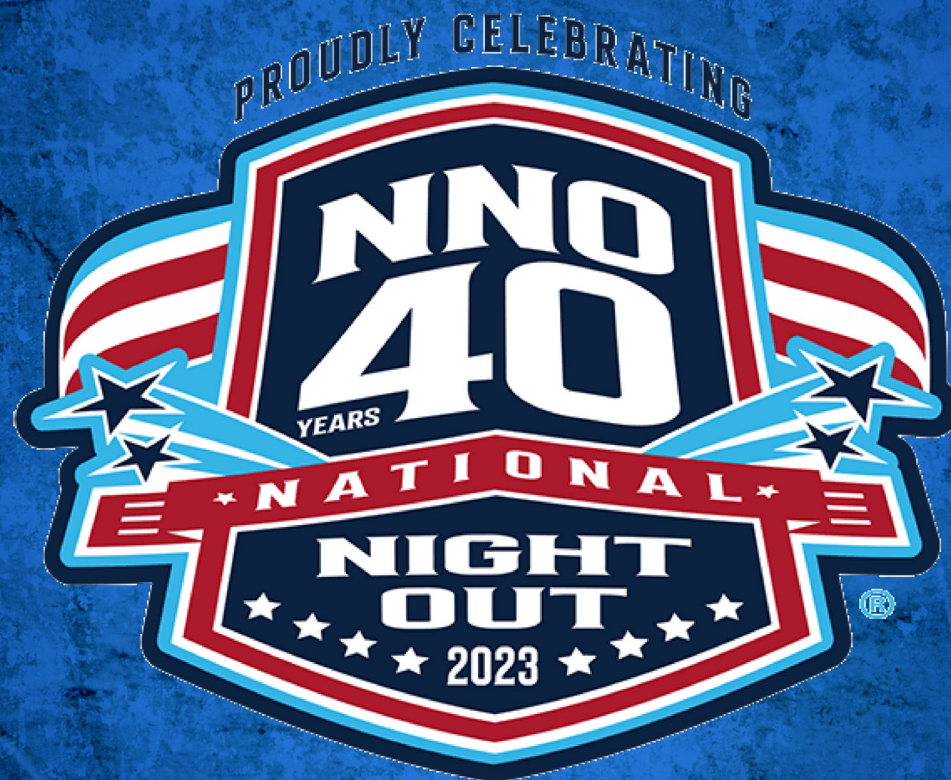

Fraud: SCAM: JOB INTERVIEW: Victim applied for a job with Creesy Everett Real Estate through Indeed.com. Victim was interviewed using the Signal app, and at the end of the interview was told they had the job. The individual who interviewed the victim stated they would send the victim a check to deposit for expenses, which the victim received and deposited into their personal account. A few days later, the victim received a second check and attempted to deposit. It was at this time the victim was informed by their banking institution the checks were fraudulent. Victim reached out to Creesy Everett Real Estate and found they had not interviewed the victim, and this had been a financial scam. Luckily, no monetary loss to the victim.

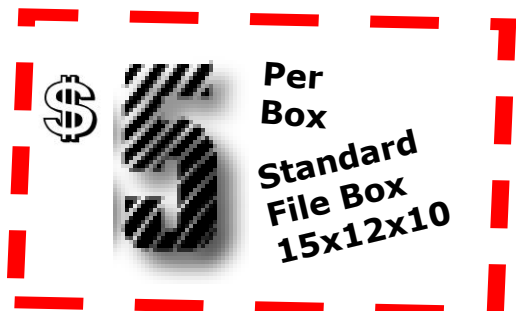

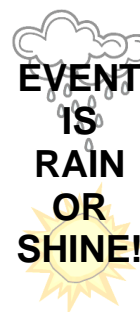
