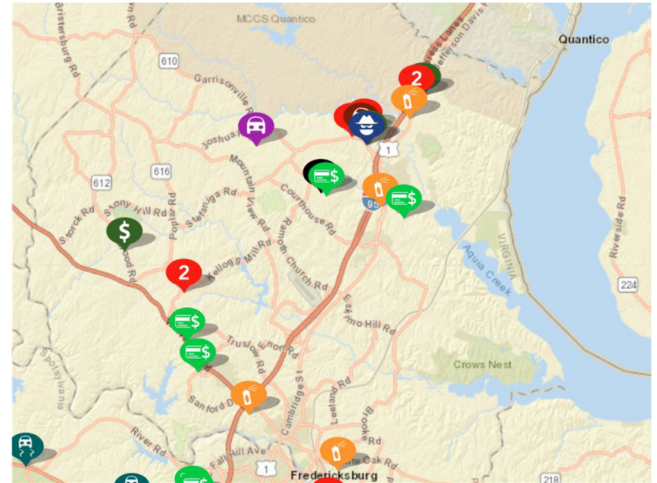

Battery Point Drive Fraud: <b>SCAM: DOMINION ENERGY:</b> Victims received a call from "John" with Dominion Energy. "John" explained the victim's account was overdue and their electricity would be cut off in 30 minutes if payment was not made immediately. "John" went on to say payment would have to be made through Zelle. "John" attempted to assist the victims in creating a Zelle account, but victims continue to struggle, and "John" ended the call. Shortly thereafter, "Trevor Davis" called and identified himself as "John's" supervisor and would assist the victim further with establishing a PayPal account in order to send payment. Victims succeeded in establishing the account, however, accidentally processed two (2) separate payments of \$323, which "Mr. Davis" said would be credited to their account. After the call ended, victims realized they had been scammed and attempted to cancel transfers, but the funds had already been transferred. Monetary loss of \$646.	Celebrate Virginia	01/04/23
